

RESOLUTION 2026-21

TO ADOPT THE 2026 MESA COUNTY MULTI-JURISDICTIONAL HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN

WHEREAS, Mesa County, in cooperation with participating municipalities, special districts, and other stakeholders, has prepared the 2026 Mesa County Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan ("Plan"); and

WHEREAS, Clifton Water District ("District") participated in the planning process, and the Plan identifies hazards, vulnerabilities, and mitigation actions relevant to the District; and

WHEREAS, adoption of the Plan supports the District's long-term resiliency efforts and helps maintain eligibility for certain hazard mitigation funding opportunities; and

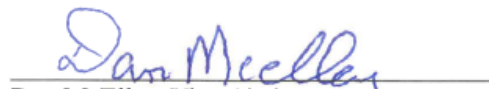
WHEREAS, the Plan is a strategic planning document and does not impose regulatory requirements, obligate the District to undertake any specific project, commit the District to expend funds, or supersede the authority of the Board of Directors regarding future budgeting and capital improvement decisions.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of the Clifton Water District:

1. **ADOPTION:** The Clifton Water District hereby adopts the 2026 Mesa County Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan as an official planning document of the District.
2. **IMPLEMENTATION:** The District may consider and implement mitigation actions identified in the Plan as resources, funding opportunities, operational needs, and priorities warrant. Adoption of the Plan shall not be construed as a commitment to fund or complete any specific mitigation action.
3. **FUTURE UPDATES:** The District supports periodic review and future updates of the Plan and authorizes District staff to participate in future plan maintenance, reporting, and update activities as appropriate.
